What is Convalescent Care?

Following surgery or illness, you may be ready to leave the hospital but are not able to return home safely.

The Convalescent Care Program provides 24-hour care to individuals who require specific medical and therapeutic services in a supportive environment.

The program will help you recover your strength and endurance before returning home.

Convalescent Care provides the care you need, when you need it. This includes;

- Medical and therapeutic support;
- A specialized care plan to help you regain your strength and independence;
- Guidance for you, and your family, on the community support services available.

How do I apply?

Referrals to the program are coordinated through the Community Care Access Centre (CCAC):

Your doctor, hospital staff and CCAC Case Manager can discuss with you how your needs could be met through the Convalescent Care program.

The Convalescent Care program is delivered in long term care homes that have met guidelines for this type of specialized care.

What does Convalescent Care cost?

There is no fee for this program. The Convalescent Care Program is funded by the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care.

How long can I access Convalescent Care?

The program is available for up to 90 days. The average length of time residents access this program is 30-45 days. To be eligible for the program, the goal is to safely return home.

What happens when I'm ready to return home?

When it is time to return home, your CCAC Case Manager will help you arrange any services and supports you need.
